Traffic Management: Works Around Elaine

There will be some intersection and access track works taking place on the Midland Highway in Elaine in September at the following intersections:-

- Murphys Lane
- Fords Lane
- Horsehill Road

Traffic management will be in place, while these works are taking place at these intersections There is expected to be minimal delays for traffic travelling along Midland Highway when these works are taking place.

Turbine components haulage route

The turbine components will arrive in November. A map of the haulage route will be posted on our website. Vestas is currently preparing a storage hardstand at the port in Geelong in readiness for the arrival of the turbine components.
