2	Update from Community Engagement Manager, report for March 2021 until August 2021			
	Landscape program			
	There have been 438 applications received of eligible dwelling owners within 4kms of the nearest turbine, for landscaping payments and 4 for actual landscaping. The landscaping program closed on 040721 for new applications. Three families are still on			

the 2 year landscaping maintenance program for those that selected actual landscaping.

For the other 3 entities mentioned in the planning permit, St Sava received a payment in lieu of landscaping, Narmbool declined landscaping and Council has requested a payment in lieu of landscaping for Lal Lal Falls.

• TV reception complaints

There have been 5 TV reception complaints in the last few months. Two dwellings receive TV reception in the opposite direction of where turbines are situated, so the issue is not wind farm related. Two have been rectified and the final one has been delayed with an assessment due to Covid 19 restrictions.

Noise testing

The first round of post construction noise monitoring program has been completed. The reports for Yendon and Elaine are being finalised by SLR and then will be reviewed by an EPA accredited auditor.

Aviation lights

Aviation lights, have been switched off since the 16 October 2020 and will remain off for the foreseeable future.

• Complaints and feedback

Health complaint, still with the wind farm commissioner.

Noise complaints, complaints have been received from 6 families, 2 at the Yendon end and 4 from Elaine. Discussions are continuing with these families.

DR asked TW about what is happening with a noise complaint from a resident on Elaine Mount Mercer Road Elaine. Discussions are continuing with this noise complainant to resolve their concerns. DR requested that this item remain on the agenda at future meetings.
