TW clarified that the landscaping program is a planning permit requirement and not a 'compensation program'. If people do not consider the amount of money on offer as not adequate for their landscaping needs, we suggest apply for the landscaping option.			
	The program will remain open from 12 months after the completion of construction. If construction is completed in September 2019, then the landscaping program will close in September 2020.
