Clean up is done, once Vestas leave the area there will be a final trim and the process of handover. 	connect which is approximately 2.5 km of cable.

	Cables are terminated in 32 towers. The first string has been patched through. Tower 31 will be finished off once crane moves. The crew will be following the crane around.  The first string to energise will be 31, 32, 36, 38.			

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	Turbines will be energised and generation will commence in April 2019.
